As it looks now, due to late delivery of drawings and or material (we are still missing some) our production dept. eds 13 production days from September 7, to finish the installation of all cable looms. We have still many Design Queries open. Together with the installation dept, we have discussed if these could endanger the installation

process. They could, but we will probably be able to solve these within the coming 2 weeks. So, they will not influence the w delivery time. Considering the above, the delivery of the aircraft will unfortunately shift to Wednesday 14 October

2009. Off course we will do everything to deliver the aircraft earlier by appointing more people than planned on the aircraft, if this helps and is possible.

Hopefully, we will encounter fewer problems with the systems to be delivered so that we may win some time at their installation.
