**Subject: European Fund for Integration of third-country nationals
Community actions - 2009 Call for proposals**

Please find enclosed the list of selected projects and the reserve list following the 2009 call for proposals for the Community Actions of the European Fund for Integration of third-country nationals (EIF).

The budget available for the work programme 2009 amounted to 6.825.000 €. The indicative distribution of this budget according to activities was 4.975.000 € for grants and 1.850.000 € for tenders. 4.580.000 € were available for the call for proposals.

Following the publication of the Call for proposals EIF Community Actions 2009 on 22 December 2009 with a deadline on 3 March 2009, 81 project proposals were received. 8 projects have been selected. 4 projects were on the reserve list of which one received an EU contribution as budget was available. 21 projects could not be selected because of lack of budget. 37 proposals were rejected because their quality was not judged to be adequate for receiving an EU contribution. One project was considered as non-financially capable. 5 projects were considered as ineligible.
