Betreft beslissing op uw Wob-verzoek

Geachte 

Bij brief van 12 juli 2012 heeft u bij de Immigratie- en Naturalisatiedienst een verzoek ingediend als bedoeld in artikel 3, eerste lid, van de Wet openbaarheid van bestuur (hierna: Wob). Op 17 juli jl. is dit verzoek voor verdere behandeling doorgestuurd aan mijn ministerie. Uw verzoek heeft betrekking op "bescheiden met betrekking tot onderzoek naar de leges die gevraagd worden in andere lidstaten van de Unie ten aanzien van langdurig ingezetene derdelanders en een afschrift van het gespreksverslag met de Europese Commissie van 29 mei 2012".

Bij brief van 7 augustus 2012 is de termijn om op uw verzoek te beslissen met vier weken verlengd.

Met betrekking tot uw verzoek om informatie bericht ik u als volgt.

Uw verzoek valt onder de reikwijdte van de Wob. Ingevolge artikel 3, vijfde lid, van de Wob wordt een verzoek om informatie ingewilligd met inachtneming van het bepaalde in de artikelen 10 en 11.

Op basis van uw verzoek om bescheiden met betrekking tot een onderzoek naar de leges die gevraagd worden in andere lidstaten van de unie zijn twee documenten aangetroffen. Het betreft een Ad Hoc Query van het EMN (European Migration Network) en een tabel met een overzicht van leges in een aantal andere landen naar aanleiding van mondelinge verzoeken om informatie. Beide documenten worden als bijlage meegezonden.

Daarnaast heeft u verzocht om een afschrift van het verslag van het gesprek met de Europese Commissie van 29 mei 2012. Van dit informele ambtelijke gesprek is geen officieel verslag aangetroffen. Wel bestaat een intern verslag waarin de persoonlijke indrukken van een deelnemer aan het gesprek zijn weergegeven.

Op grond van artikel 10, tweede lid, aanhef en onder e, van de Wob blijft verstrekking van informatie achterwege voor zover het belang daarvan niet opweegt tegen het belang dat de persoonlijke levenssfeer van bij de openbaarmaking betrokken personen wordt geëerbiedigd.

In dit document staan persoonsgegevens. Ik ben van oordeel dat ten aanzien van deze gegevens het belang dat de persoonlijke levenssfeer van betrokkene(n) wordt geëerbiedigd, zwaarder moet wegen dan het belang van openbaarheid.

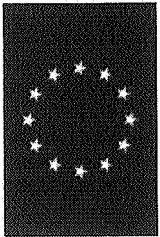

		In relation to residence permits that must, in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No. 380/2008 (OJ L 115 of 29.04.2008), be presented as separate documents using electronic storage and processing media, §§ 44 – 45 German Ordinance Governing Residence stipulate that the fee for the issuing of a permanent settlement permit shall be 250 euros in respect of persons who are highly qualified, 200 euros in respect of the exercise of self-employment and in all other cases 135 euros. The fee in respect of an unlimited permit to remain permanently within the EU, the fee will also be 135 euros. For the issuing of a short-term residence permit with a period of validity of up to one year, a fee of 100 euros is charged, and should the period of validity be in excess of one year, the fee is 110 euros. 		In the event that the residence permit is only presented on a standardised model form in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No. 1030/2002 (OJ L 157 of 15.06.2002, p. 1), the aforementioned tariffs will be reduced by 50 euros across the board if it is necessary for the permit to be presented in this form for the purpose of the avoidance of exceptional hardship; the fee will be 15 euros if the residence permit that is to be issued on such a standardised model form is for the purpose of the extension of the duration of the stay by one month (§ 45b German Ordinance Governing Residence).
		The handling fee charged in respect of the processing of an application shall, in the case of a residence permit and of a permit to remain permanently within the EU, be half the full fee and in the case of a residence permit the fee shall be the full amount payable in respect of the issuing of said document. No processing fee shall be charged in the event of the application being rejected because the authority in question is not competent to handle it or because the applicant is not legally capable of acting, or in the event of the application being withdrawn before its administrative processing shall have begun (§ 49 Ordinance Governing Residence).
