




A Bird's Eye View of the Economy


Relatively small country, a surface of not even 7% of Ukraine with 16.7 million inhabitants but:

- The 17th economy worldwide with a GDP of 790 billion USD
- The 2nd exporter of agricultural products
- The 5th largest exporter and the 7th importer of goods and services
- The 9th largest foreign investor in the world
- Close to 10.000 foreign companies active in the Netherlands

Reason 2: Infrastructure

Airports	Schiphol A'dam: Europe's third largest ("Best Airport W-Europe")
Highways	NL: second highest density in Europe
Internet	Amsterdam: world's number one internet hub

Reason 3: Innovation & High Tech




Knowledge Economy



Pioneers in international business

- April '94 Netherlands and Ukraine signed Bilateral Investment Treaty to protect private investments in either countries.
- In 1995 Ukraine and the Netherlands signed Taxation Agreement
- In addition in 1996 and 2003: Ukrainian Foreign Investment Law
