The animal was entered in the stud book at CRV on 16-06-2015 according to the information below. On the other hand, according to the official information, CRV has only been running a breeding programme for the breed "Wagyu" since 2019. The breeding certificate is therefore to be considered invalid. Furthermore, it is noted that the owner of the animal must obligatorily be indicated in the zootechnical certificate at the time of issue of a zootechnical certificate.

Against this background, I would be grateful if the competent Dutch zootechnical authority could declare the zootechnical certificate for the Wagyu cow DE 09 456 40764 to be invalid and collect it, and give some feedback on it.

according to an information from the competent authority [REDACTED] the German "Fleischrinderverband Bayern e.V." has presented the attached breeding certificate.

The animal in question, a Wagyu cow born in Germany, was found to be inconsistent with the herd book entry. In particular, there is no information on the animal breeding certificate regarding registration in the herd-book class and the owner. Furthermore, it is suspected that the zootechnical certificate was issued by the breeding organisation Coöperatie Koninklijke CRV u.a. (see more: www.cooperatie-crv.nl) subsequently, after the death of the animal for a client who is not the owner of the animal and member of CRV.

According to the information in our central database Hi-Tier (www.hi-tier.de/), the animal has been exported from the Netherlands into Germany on 11.06.2015. After this time a breeding certificate for the animal was issued for a breeder resident in Germany, so that there is a suspicion that the animal was not exported at all or that a breeding certificate for the animal was unlawfully applied for and / or issued.

In 2015 Cooperative CRV u.a. was recognized to keep a studbook for Wagyu under the previous animal breeding regulation and was allowed to issue zootechnical. As mentioned on the certificate, the wagyu cow was entered into the main section of the studbook. The information on the list of recognized breeding organizations on our website indicates when the breeding program was approved under the ABR (2016/1012), hence the date of 2019.

We agree that the zootechnical certificate that was issued does not meet the requirements of the ABR. The information regarding this cow should have been presented in another way. Cooperative CRV u.a. has therefore revoked the certificate and has it declared to be null and void. The letter regarding this matter was sent today to the person who requested the certificate.
